HARVEST:

Average Sugar: 24 Brix

Acidity: 0.61 g/100ml

pH: 3.72 units Res Sugar: 0.43%

FERMENTATION AND AGING:

Fermented in stainless steel tanks and pumped over twice a day for two weeks. Drained and pressed into 50% new French and American oak barrels.

CHARACTERISTICS:

This wine is dark red in color with rich, toasted oak aromas from extended time in the barrel. Caramelized plum and black currant aromas are followed by black pepper and anise flavors. There is a rich mouth-feel and polished tannins in the long-lasting finish. "Helluva good wine!" -Nils Venge
